Summary:

Providing notice to the City Council of the intent of the City Clerk to hold an election to fill one vacancy and one term expiration on the Retirement Hearing Commission.

Committee/Commission Action: None.

Background Information:

The Retirement Hearing Commission hears issues and appeals relating to the City of Sacramento Employees Retirement System (SCERS). The Commission seats five members, two of which are required to be elected by active members of SCERS. The procedure for conducting this type of election is outlined in Resolution 89-712. As required by the Resolution, the City Council is being advised of the intent to hold an election.

If more than one candidate per seat is nominated, an election will be held. If only one candidate is nominated for each seat, then those candidates shall be deemed automatically elected by the City Clerk. A tentative election is scheduled for March 31, 2006, and will be conducted by mail ballot. If one candidate (for each seat) does not receive a majority of votes cast, the top-two vote receivers will participate in a run-off election scheduled for April 18, 2006. As required by the election procedures, the City Clerk will notify the City Council of the results.


Financial Considerations: None.
