

ORDINANCE NO. 1080, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the available funds not heretofore appropriated, the following sums:

The sum of \$5000.00 to Budget 41 "Sewers" for Repairs and Replacements.

The sum of \$1395.00 to Budget 48 "Memorial Auditorium" for Salaries and Wages.


The sum of \$1665.00 to Budget 34 "Bacteriological Laboratory" for Salaries and Wages.

The sum of \$796.45 to Budget 21 "Fire Department" for Additions and Betterments.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the immediate appropriation of this money is necessary to carry on the functions of the City of Sacramento Government.
