1. Regional Transit Monthly Status Report

DISCUSSION: David Boggs, Regional Transit General Manager, reported that the Buy America issue had been resolved but that the agreement had not been signed. Also that the first phase of the project is 76% completed.

Councilman Kastanis asked for a status on the completion date for the K Street Mall. Mr. Boggs replied that the completion date is set for November 25, 1986. Mr. Boggs also reported that there is 6 to 8 miles of track set and that the vehicles were being tested.

REPORT(S) BACK: Councilman Kastanis stated that he had asked for an informational report on the status of rate project in other cities and wanted to know when he could expect such a report. Mr. Boggs replied that the report was near completion and would be submitted as soon as it was completed.

DISCUSSION:


