BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency has an opportunity to secure the temporary services of Marvin D. Laskey, Community Development Representative from the HUD office in San Francisco under the Intergovernmental Personnel Act. This program has as its basis the goal of improving HUD's own delivery system and at the same time, increasing the capacities of local governments to solve their own problems by borrowing personnel with knowledge or skills in a specific process or program.

This one year program (with possibility of a one year extension) requires the local agency to pay 51% of the employee's annual salary. In this instance, the Housing and Redevelopment Agency would reimburse HUD in the amount of \$15,537 (annual salary is presently \$30,464) plus a share of any federal raise approved in 1980. Fringe benefit costs continue to be borne by HUD.

The Agency will utilize Mr. Laskey's abilities primarily in the McClellan Redevelopment Project, in Community Development Activities as needed and in Housing programs requiring liaison with HUD, where his expertise should be of special value to the Agency.

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Mr. Laskey has had many years of experience with HUD and has been the HUD Field Representative to Sacramento for approximately eight (8) years.

FINANCIAL DATA

The required payment to HUD of \$15,537 would be provided from each program in which Mr. Laskey performs work. Staff time expended on the McClellan Project will be paid by the County, City and McClellan AFB.


RECOMMENDATION
