**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE 48TH STREET
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT (PN:TR02)**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

48th Street between H Street and J Street. Council District 3.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Accept the bid of Florez Paving in the amount of \$205,861; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the 48th Street Reconstruction Project (PN:TR02).

SUMMARY:

This project will reconstruct 48th Street between H Street and J Street. The improvements include construction of asphalt concrete pavement, curb, gutter, handicap ramps, traffic signal modifications and drain inlets, and relocation of the water main.

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The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate the roadway, improve drainage, revitalize the neighborhood, and improve the overall aesthetics in the area.

The Negative Declaration for this project will be filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento after approval by City Council. A Mitigation Reporting Program has been prepared to ensure compliance with the mitigation measures.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- This project was authorized in the 1998/1999 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on April 7, 1999 and are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount	ESBE Participation Goal
Florez Paving	\$205,861	96.60%
Biondi Paving	\$281,530	91.07%
Azteca Construction	\$290,535	92.37%

- The construction estimate was \$225,460.
- Award to Florez Paving is recommended.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction, and construction engineering costs, is \$343,150.
- The project budget for the 48th Street Reconstruction Project is \$438,730.
- The unobligated Measure A Sales Tax Fund 201 balance as of April 19, 1999, is \$388,318. These funds are sufficient for award.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the

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proposed project. As a result, it was determined that the proposed project will not have any significant adverse impact on the environment and a Negative Declaration was prepared. The 30-day comment period has elapsed and no comments have been received. The Negative Declaration for this project was approved by City Council on April 20, 1999, and filed with the County Clerk.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:


To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to 8 plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication. All are directly involved with ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. Project notices were sent to 30 organizations involved in ESBE recruitment. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at www.sacto.org/bids.
