

# RESOLUTION No. 904

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 14, 1941

## CANVASS OF VOTE MUNICIPAL COURT

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on date of November 4, 1941, in accordance with provisions of Ordinance No. 931, Fourth Series, adopted by the City Council September 26, 1941; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by provisions of said ordinance, consolidated the conduct of said Special Election with Regular Municipal Election held on said date, for the purpose of the election of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing ordinance was duly published in accordance with law and said election held in each precinct established for the conduct thereof; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of the election have been canvassed by this body covering as a Canvassing Board and the results thereof duly ascertained.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED, that the total number of votes cast at said election were 25,508; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED, that the total number of Absentee Votes for said Proposition were 109 and that the number of Absentee Votes against said Proposition were 42.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total number of votes (including Absentee) cast in favor of establishing a Municipal Court for the City of Sacramento were 12,370, and that the total number of votes (including Absentee) cast against said proposition were 8,137; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposition for the establishment of a Municipal Court for the City of Sacramento having received more than a majority of the votes cast thereon, is hereby declared to have been carried by the vote of the people at said election on date of November 4, 1941.
