Paul J. Arino, Patrolman (Continued from July 24, 1973)


The Civil Service Board met in executive session, in the Personnel Department Examination and Conference Room, at 1:00 p.m., to consider the disposition of Patrolman Paul J. Arino's appeal after having concluded its hearing on July 24, 1973.

After deliberation the Board convened the meeting to announce its decision.


It was the unanimous decision of the Board that the appeal of Paul J. Arino be granted, in that evidence presented by the City had failed to establish dishonesty as charged. However, it was the opinion of the Board that Officer Arino did not exercise proper judgment and discretion in his handling of the incident at 3030 "O" Street.

The Board was also of the opinion that the Internal Affairs Division investigation of the entire incident was improperly conducted.

It was suggested by the Board that a firm policy for booking property be established by the Sacramento Police Department.
