

ORDINANCE NO. 1473, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE TRAFFIC CONTROL EQUIPMENT IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, in the open market without advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter, TRAFFIC CONTROL EQUIPMENT, for the sum of \$1721.25.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that delivery of said equipment cannot be had without waiting a long period of time and same is needed for the proper operation of traffic signals.
