

RESOLUTION No. 130

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

March 29, 1940

AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF PROPERTY FOR THE OPENING AND EXTENDING OF 37TH STREET FROM 4TH AVENUE TO SACRAMENTO BOULEVARD

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the purchase of the following described property, in the City of Sacramento, from Raymond L. Ackeret be, and the same is, hereby authorized at a consideration of \$3150.00.

Said property is described as follows:

All that portion of Lot A, as shown on the official "Amended Map of Subdivision C of South Sacramento" recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, December 2, 1891, in Book 3 of Maps, Map No. 3, described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the south line of Cypress (now Fourth) Avenue, distant 48.6 feet west of the northeast corner of said Lot A; running thence south, and parallel to the east line of said Lot A, 98.47 feet to a stake; thence west, and parallel to the north line of said Lot A, 48.6 feet to the east line of the "Flat Iron Tract," according to the official plat thereof recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, April 4, 1906, in Book 7 of Maps, Map No. 1; thence north, along the east line of said "Flat Iron Tract," 98.47 feet to the south line of Cypress (now Fourth) Avenue; and thence east, along the south line of said avenue, 48.6 feet, to the place of beginning.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Controller be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant in the said amount of \$3150.00 for the purchase of said property, to be delivered to the City of Sacramento free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.
