

ORDINANCE NO. 2003, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY KNOWN AS "SOUTH SACRAMENTO SCHOOL DISTRICT AREA;" PROVIDING FOR FURNISHING OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES BEGINNING APRIL 1, 1958; PROVIDING FURTHER THAT THE AREA SHALL BECOME A PART OF SACRAMENTO CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, TO BECOME EFFECTIVE 30 DAYS AFTER PASSAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the annexation to the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, of all that certain territory known as "SOUTH SACRAMENTO SCHOOL DISTRICT AREA," situate in the County of Sacramento, State of California, contiguous to said city and which is hereinafter described, all in accordance with the provisions of the Annexation Act of 1913, as amended, and also pursuant to an election duly and regularly held within the said territory on the 25th day of March, 1957, at which election a majority of all of the votes cast by the qualified electors therein were in favor of the annexation of said territory to the City of Sacramento, be, and the same is hereby approved and allowed. And by reason of the aforesaid premises, the said territory is by this ordinance declared annexed to, incorporated in and made a part of the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, for all purposes.

That the outer boundaries of "SOUTH SACRAMENTO SCHOOL DISTRICT AREA," hereby annexed, is particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of 32nd Street and the center line of the alley first north of 19th Avenue; thence easterly along the center line of said alley and its easterly projection to the center line of Sacramento Boulevard; thence southerly along the center line of Sacramento Boulevard to the center line of 23rd Avenue; thence easterly along the center line of 23rd Avenue to the northerly projection of the westerly line of the Fruitridge Tract, the same as is shown in Book 5 of Maps, Map No. 10 filed in the Office of the Recorder of Sacramento County; thence southerly along the west line of said Fruitridge Tract and its southerly projection to the center line of Fruitridge Road; thence westerly along the center line of Fruitridge Road to the center line of Franklin Boulevard; thence southerly along the center line of Franklin Boulevard to the east-west center line of Section 30, T. 8 N., R. 5 E., thence westerly along the center line of said section to the city limits line of the City of Sacramento; thence generally northerly and easterly along said city limits line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. That the tax rate to be fixed for the area herein annexed shall not include any of the outstanding bonded indebtedness of the city incurred prior to the date of annexation thereof.

SECTION 3. That the annexation of said territory to the city shall become effective from and after April 1, 1958, all in accordance with the Notice of Election and the provisions of Section 35146 of the Government Code of California.

SECTION 4. That said area shall become a part of the Sacramento City Unified School District, all in accordance with the provisions of Section 2421.5 of the Education Code.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be published once in the "SACRAMENTO UNION," a newspaper of general circulation and the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento and the ordinance shall be effective 30 days from and after its passage.
