ACCEPTANCE OF AUGMENTATION TO FY10 GANG VIOLENCE SUPPRESSION GRANT

- A. The State of California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) Gang Violence Suppression (GVS) program allows local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control gang activity.
- B. As a current grantee, the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) was given an augmentation of \$199,965. The SPD is requesting approval to accept and use the funding for continued gang violence suppression through December 31, 2011.

Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to adjust the necessary revenue and expense budgets for Project #G11006600 to implement the \$199,965 GVS augmentation.
