

ORDINANCE NO. 1616, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN MATERIALS AND HAVE THE WORK OF REPAIRING THE 2,000 FEET OF PILING AT THE CITY SEWAGE PUMPING STATION DONE BY CITY FORCES WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain construction materials and have the work of repairing 2,000 feet of 12 to 15 inch piling done at the City Sewage Pumping Station, by city forces, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost of completion of this work is \$1500.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of starting the work of repairing 2,000 feet of piling at the City Sewage Pumping Station, without delay.
