Closed Session Report

Action: Moved, seconded, carried unanimously (Fargo/Tretheway), sitting as the Board for the Redevelopment Agency, to authorize the Redevelopment Agency (Agency) to enter into a settlement agreement with Mo Mohanna and all related entities of all lawsuits listed on the Closed Session agenda, both for the City Council and the Agency, and to authorize Assistant City Manager, John Dangberg, to execute the agreement and all related agreements.

The terms of the Settlement Agreement are: All nine properties on the 700 and 800 blocks of K Street, including affiliate-owned properties owned by Mo Mohanna, will be purchased by the Agency for \$18.6 million. Mo Mohanna agreed to dismiss all lawsuits as listed on the Closed Session agenda. The Agency has an Exclusive Right to Negotiate (ERN) with Bob Leach, Principal, USA Hospitality. The Settlement Agreement is part of a court-approved Settlement subject to court enforcement. The ERN has a nine month due diligence period in which the negotiation for a proposed project of a 400 room hotel on K

Street and a mixed-use project on L Street will occur. During this ninth month period, the Agency will review the project, financials, and underwrite the project before bringing the Disposition and Development Agreement (DDA) to City Council for approval. DDA terms require that the project to be completed within 5 years and the property purchased at \$150/sq. ft. The Agency is not obligated to enter into a DDA.
