

# RESOLUTION No. 817

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, Under and by virtue of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 304 (4S), the City Manager has designated all regulatory, warning and guide signs, signals, markings and the traffic control devices heretofore erected or placed or caused to be erected or placed by him as official and has designated, subject to the provisions of the California State Motor Vehicle Code, that the character of all official regulatory, warning and guide signs, signals, markings and traffic control devices erected or placed after November 27 1937 shall be in substantial conformity with the character of those set forth and described in a publication entitled: "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", approved by the American Association of State Highway Officials and by the National Conference on Street and Highway Safety, Washington, D.C., November 1935, copy attached hereto,

NOW, THEREFORE, to make such designation a matter of Council Record, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That such designation be confirmed, approved and ratified.
