Issued By The Mayor

FLOOD AWARENESS WEEK
November 30 - December 5, 1987

WHEREAS, in recent years California suffered severe winds and rainstorms; and

WHEREAS, residents need to understand the importance of preparing their homes and property for winter storms; and

WHEREAS, under the coordination of the Governor's Office of Emergency Services and the California Department of Water Resources, a number of local, state, federal, and volunteer agencies are observing Flood Awareness Week to educate the public on this important issue;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anne Rudin, Mayor of the City of Sacramento, do hereby proclaim November 30 through December 5, 1987 as FLOOD AWARENESS WEEK. During this week, residents of Sacramento and other communities are urged to join together and share information about how they can protect their lives and property from floods and how they can work to promote wise floodplain management.
