AWARD CONTRACT FOR S. LAND PARK WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT – PHASE 3 (Z14010009)

BACKGROUND

- A. The existing water distribution system in the South Land Park area is deteriorated beyond rehabilitation. In order to improve reliability and health and safety, City Council approved the South Land Park Steel Water Main Replacement Project, Phase 3 (Z14010009) budget in fiscal year 2007/08.
- B. City staff prepared a set of plans and specifications to construct 6500 lineal feet of water distribution mains complete with new water services, water meters, and fire hydrants.
- C. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on November 12th, 2008. Florez Paving, Inc, was the lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the S. Land Park Water Main Replacement – Phase 3 (Z14010009) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Florez Paving, for an amount not to exceed \$ 796,015.
