Ms. Bronda Silva, Senior Personnel Analyst, addressed the Board. Ms. Silva informed the Board that the City is currently in the process of purchasing new mobile data terminals for the Police and Fire Departments. The new classification of Telecommunications Engineer will be responsible for the planning and design of various communications systems while the Supervisor and Technician levels will be responsible for the installation, maintenance and repair of these systems. The first and second readings are requested due to the urgency to get the new mobile data terminals installed on schedule.

Mr. Ron Costa, Communications Systems Manager, answered questions of the Board.

Local 39 and the Western Council of Engineers have been contacted and are in agreement with the new classifications.

A motion was made to approve the new classifications of Telecommunications Engineer, Telecommunications Supervisor, and Telecommunications Technician Trainee/I/II for first and second readings.


