**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND CONTRACT AWARD TO GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$510,528 (PN:TW36)**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Marysville Boulevard between I/80 and Arcade Creek, Council District 2.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Accept the bid of Granite Construction in the amount of \$510,528; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Marysville Boulevard Streetscape Project (PN:TW36).

**SUMMARY:**

The project consists of constructing improvements, including stamped asphalt concrete, curb ramps, planting, irrigation, drainage facilities and striping on Marysville Boulevard.

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The purpose of the project is to increase ADA accessibility by installing curb ramps, improve drainage, revitalize the neighborhood, and improve the overall aesthetics in the area.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- This project was authorized in the 2000/2001 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on December 13, 2000 and are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount	DBE Participation Goal 20%
Granite Construction	\$510,528.00	41.59%
Biondi Paving	\$541,474.75	84.99%
Florez Paving	\$556,862.72	19.69%
Olympic Landscaping	\$568,117.85	0%

- The construction estimate was \$425,620.
- Granite Construction is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and has exceeded the project DBE goal.
- Award to Granite Construction is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction, and construction engineering costs is \$669,726.
- The budget for the Marysville Boulevard Streetscape Project is \$674,424.
- A Supplemental Agreement in the amount \$117,000 was approved by the City Council on December 17, 2000.
- As of January 22, 2001, the total unobligated Measure A Sales Tax Fund 201, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund 205, Housing/Redevelopment Agency Fund 206, and Federal Capital Grant Fund 511 balance is \$606,203. These funds are sufficient for award.

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**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section Number 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines. The Notice of Exemption was filed on December 15, 2000.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3.

**ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:**

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to 8 plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication. All are directly involved with ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. Project notices were sent to 30 organizations involved in ESBE recruitment. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at [www.cityofsacramento.org/bids](http://www.cityofsacramento.org/bids)
