

Resolution of Award No. 2480

2480

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 29th day of **May**, 1942, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned;

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **E. F. Hilliard**

at the prices specified in **his** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **the alley between Capitol Avenue and "N" Street, from the easterly line of 22nd Street, to the pavement in place approximately 160 feet easterly therefrom,**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2480, passed and adopted by said City Council on **April 24**, 1942, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, **and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.**

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the "**Sacramento Union**," a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
