## ORDINANCE NO. 1068, FOURTH SERIES:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1066, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 10, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1026, 1031, 1045, 1047, 1052, 1053 AND 1065, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE FOURTH SERIES, BY AMENDING SECTION 3, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 1066-FOURTH SERIES IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

RECEIVING IN EXCESS OF SALARY STEP.

SECTION 3: Any employee who on December 1, 1944, was occupying a position classified herein and who immediately prior to the adoption of Ordinance 1026-Fourth Series was receiving a salary or wage in excess of the salary or wage provided in Ordinance 1026-Fourth Series for the proper salary step for such classification of employment, shall, from Julylst, 1945, receive such salary or wage and in addition, the sum of \$10.00 per month.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being to provide for the salaries of City Employees for the 1945-46 fiscal year.
