

RESOLUTION No. 344

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
June 25, 1936

RESOLUTION APPROVING BOND OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY EXECUTED IN CONSIDERATION OF THE GRANT BY THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO OF THE FRANCHISE TO USE THE STREETS OF SAID CITY TO TRANSMIT AND DISTRIBUTE GAS FOR ALL PURPOSES OTHER THAN THOSE AUTHORIZED UNDER SECTION 19 OF ARTICLE XI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AS SAID SECTION EXISTED PRIOR TO ITS AMENDMENT ON OCTOBER 10, 1911.

WHEREAS on the 18th day of June, 1936, the City Council of the City of Sacramento struck off and awarded to Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of California, the franchise to use the public streets, ways and places of said city to transmit and distribute gas for all purposes other than those authorized under Section 19 of Article XI of the Constitution of the State of California as said section existed prior to its amendment on October 10, 1911, upon the terms and conditions as set forth in that certain resolution passed by said City Council on May 7, 1936; and


WHEREAS said Pacific Gas and Electric Company, pursuant to the law and the provisions of the resolution which was adopted by said City Council on the 7th day of May, 1936, has duly executed and filed with this Council a bond in the penal sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), bearing date the 18th day of June, 1936, and conditioned as prescribed by law and by the last mentioned resolution; and

WHEREAS upon due investigation and consideration, it appears to the satisfaction of this Council that said bond is in proper form and that said bond has been duly executed by said Pacific Gas and Electric Company and by two good and sufficient sureties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that said bond be, and it is hereby accepted and approved.
