

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2619

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described, in the City of Sacramento, State of California, should be done:

NOW THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of the said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City, to-wit:

To close, vacate and abandon the following described Alley:

The Alley in the Conley Tract (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) located between 7th and 8th Avenues for 310 feet West of 58th Street reserving however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct, sewer, water, and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said Alley or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid closing are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.


And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described, and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected and benefited by said work and improvement, and that therefore the entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon, said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and the exterior boundaries of the lands affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Bounded on the North by 7th Avenue;
On the South by 8th Avenue;
On the East by 58th Street,
On the West by a tract of land lying between Verna Tract and Morris Tract (as the same are shown on the official plats thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder).

And the City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of "Division 9, Part 3, Streets and Highways Code" the "Street Vacation Act of 1941", being an Act of Legislature of the State of California, Approved May 13, 1941; and hereby fixes the 21st day of March, 1947 at 8:00 o'clock P.M., in the City Council Chamber in the Sacramento City Hall on I Street, between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place when and where any and all persons interested in said work and improvement may appear before the said City Council of said City and be heard by said City Council upon such appeal, and show cause, if any they have, why the said improvement should not be made.

The Sacramento Union is hereby designated as the daily newspaper published and circulated in said City, in which this Resolution shall be published; and the Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this Resolution in the manner prescribed by Law.
