

# RESOLUTION No. 11

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, It is the policy of the Bureau of Trade and Industrial Education in the California Department of Education to train certain qualified men in the fire service as instructors so that they may be used as instructors in fire training schools in neighboring cities, and

WHEREAS, several firemen in the Sacramento Fire Department have received such instruction and are competent to act as instructors in other cities, and

WHEREAS, these firemen cannot be assigned to such duties without the consent of the City Council in view of the provisions of Section 105 of the City Charter,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Consent of the City Council is hereby given to designation by the City Manager and the Chief of the Fire Department of firemen qualified to act as such instructors.
