The attached resolution authorizes the Executive Director to submit grant applications to the Area 4 Agency on Aging for Title III-B, III-C1, and III-C2 Older Americans Act funds for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program's fiscal year 1980-81 operations, and to execute contracts upon award of the grants.

This application marks the beginning of the seventh operational year for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program (SENP). Presently, the Program is serving over 1,100 seniors each day at seventeen nutrition sites located throughout the City and County. Of these meals, 140 are delivered to homebound seniors. In addition to the meals, the Program provides 247 units of transportation to seniors and shopping service for 88 homebound seniors each week.

In the past, SENP's various services were funded through one grant under Title VII of the Older Americans Act. In 1978, when the Older Americans Act was amended, Title VII services were segregated into three separate titles; Title III-B for supportive services (transportation, Shopper Aide Program); Title III-C1 for congregate meals; and Title III-C2 for home-delivered meals. Effective July 1, 1980, separate grant applications are required for funds under each of these Titles. The subject grant applications are for the Program's new fiscal year, July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981.

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FINANCIAL DATA

The fiscal year 1980-81 funding levels for the three service components are as follows:

- Title III-B: \$15,459.00 for shopping assistance for homebound elderly.
\$20,000.00 (approximate) for transportation services to and from the nutrition sites.
- Title III-C1: \$477,695.00 for congregate meals.
- Title III-C2: \$70,196.00 for home-delivered meals.

The total of \$590,440.00 includes a \$47,038.00 increase for fiscal year 80-81.

These grants require a 10% match in the form of either cash, in-kind services, or a combination of both. The match for these grants will be comprised mostly of in-kind volunteer services by Program participants; the remainder is available through a portion of a County General Funds Grant administered by the Sacramento County Health Department.



1. The Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento hereby approves said applications for Title III-B, III-C1, and III-C2, Older Americans Act funds.


2. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to submit said applications to the Area 4 Agency on Aging for funding as follows:
