**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME ZONE ON A PORTION OF 11<sup>TH</sup> STREET.**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

11<sup>TH</sup> Street, east side, from R to S Streets. Council District 4.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to establish a two-hour parking time zone on the east side of 11<sup>th</sup> Street between R/S alley and S Streets.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends a two-hour parking time zone be established on the east side of 11<sup>th</sup> Street between R/S alley and S Streets (Exhibit A). Regulating parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by all day commuter parkers and provide additional customer parking for businesses.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Parking is currently unregulated on the east side of 11<sup>th</sup> Street between R/S alley and S Streets.
- Business owners along this portion of 11<sup>th</sup> Street requested that the City establish a two-hour parking time limit.
- A two-hour parking time limit will relieve the parking congestion caused by all day commuter parkers and provide additional street parking for customers.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking & Animal Care Services operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.

The following streets shall be regulated with two-hour parking from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. except Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays:

- 11<sup>th</sup> Street, east side, from R/S alley to S Streets.
