SUBJECT: Report on Bids for WASTE REMOVAL FLEET MAINTENANCE BUILDING AND ALSO THE TIRE STORAGE BUILDING

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. One bid was received and the City Engineer recommends that the bid be rejected and that the project be readvertised for bids to be received on December 9, 1980.

BACKGROUND:

On October 21, 1980 the City Council approved plans and specifications for the subject project and one bid was received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on November 12, 1980. The bid received is as follows:

Tayco, Inc. \$56,294.00


The engineer's estimate for this project is \$55,600.00

A survey of prospective construction firms indicates that many did not know of the proposed project and indicated that a bid would be submitted if it were readvertised.


RECOMMENDATION:
