

RESOLUTION No. 67

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

May 3, 1946


WHEREAS, during World War II, the City of Sacramento leased its airport to the War Department of the United States Government as an aid to national defense; and

WHEREAS, the United States Government has not seen fit to terminate said lease but desires to allow the City of Sacramento re-entry upon said airport under the terms of a license; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City Council of the City of Sacramento authorize an agent of said city to request, negotiate and accept the use of the Sacramento Municipal Airport on such terms as are agreeable with the United States Government,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager of the City of Sacramento be and he is hereby authorized to request, negotiate and accept the use of the Sacramento Municipal Airport under the terms of an interim permit pending the termination of the lease now existing between the United States Government and the City of Sacramento for said airport.
