

Sacramento, California.

July 13, 1929.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date in their office, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Weisman and Chenu.
ABSENT : Commissioner Mason.

The minutes of the previous meeting of July 11th, 1929, were read and approved as corrected.

Upon motion by Commissioner Weisman, seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried, the Secretary was instructed to return the pay roll of Owen Orr to the Engineering Department for explanation; and to direct a letter to the City Manager as follows:

"In reply to your communication of July 11, 1929, we would respectfully call your attention to Ordinance No. 15, Fourth Series, Article 6, Section 1, in which a River Patrol Officer is designated as an employee of the Health Department.

"We have an eligible list from which that department can select a person to perform the duties of River Patrol Officer. We are of the opinion that if the provisions of the said ordinance are carried out it will not be necessary for the Civil Service Board to hold an examination for River Patrol Officer, or to create an eligible list as requested in your letter."

Upon motion by Commissioner Weisman, seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried, July 17, 1929, at 7:00 o'clock P.M., was set as the date for the Personal Fitness Test for Stenographer and Typists.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:30 o'clock P.M. to meet again July 17, 1929, at 7:00 o'clock P.M.
