RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF

THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

On motion of Councilman Nielsen, duly seconded and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THAT WHEREAS, Sacramento Municipal Utility District has acquired fee title in and to the hereinafter described real property, and that

WHEREAS, said District has requested the cancellation of any and all uncollected taxes, penalties, and costs heretofore levied by the city of Sacramento on said real property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that all taxes, penalties, and costs levied by the city of Sacramento be and the same are hereby cancelled; that the controller of the said city be and he is hereby directed to carry into effect this order; and that the assessor of the said city be and he is hereby directed to reassess any property not acquired by said District which is affected by this order. The real property affected by this order is described as follows:

The southerly 122 feet of that certain real property situate in the city of Sacramento, county of Sacramento, State of California, bounded as follows:

Beginning at the monument marking the intersection of the center lines of Folsom Boulevard and 59th Street established by the City Engineer of the City of Sacramento; thence South $18^{\circ} 47' 30''$ West 472.72 feet along the center line of 59th Street to the Northeasterly corner of the 10.2 acre tract of land described in deed executed by Earl P. Davis and Byron B. Davis to Pacific Gas and Electric Company, dated July 31, 1926, recorded August 2, 1926, in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 90 of Official Records, at page 51; thence North $70^{\circ} 31' 15''$ West 1051.81 feet along the Northerly line of said 10.2 acre tract to the Northwesterly corner thereof; thence North $19^{\circ} 34' 45''$ East 568.67 feet to an unmarked $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter iron pipe monument; thence continuing North $19^{\circ} 34' 45''$ East 32.72 feet to a point on the center line of Folsom Boulevard; thence South $63^{\circ} 30'$ East 1052.98 feet along said center line of Folsom Boulevard to the point of beginning.
