SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for  
Traffic Signals and Street Lighting System  
at 24th Street and 57th Avenue

SUMMARY

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

FINANCIAL DATA

IN FY 1977-1978 the City Council approved in the Engineering Budget \$60,000 in Gas Tax 2106 funds for the subject project. Total amount currently available for this project is \$55,218. Total estimated construction cost is \$80,000.

The following is a breakdown of cost required for 24th Street and 57th Avenue Traffic Signals.

Estimated Construction Cost	\$80,000
Estimated Engineering Cost	<u>8,000</u>
Total Project Cost	\$88,000
Less Budget Amount	<u>60,000</u>
<b>TOTAL ESTIMATED CITY FUNDS REQUIRED</b>	<b>\$28,000</b>

The total estimate of additional City funds to be budgeted will necessitate an additional appropriation of funds which will be requested at the time of bid award.

RECOMMENDATION


