

RESOLUTION No. 2117
RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

July 28, 1927.

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the cost and expenses of improving 6th Avenue, from the easterly line of Freeport Boulevard to the westerly right-of-way line of the Western Pacific Railway,

in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2117.


