“Please Abide, Move Aside” Week January 18-22, 1999

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento Fire Department obtained a grant from the State Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) to sponsor the *Please Abide, Move Aside Campaign*; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides a full scale public education campaign that will be launched to encourage the driving public to yield safely to responding emergency vehicles; and

WHEREAS, a number of methods will be employed to provide this education, namely printed material, presentations and public service announcements, with the intent to saturate the public with an abundance of emergency vehicle response procedure information, with the immediate expectation that the number of collisions involving public safety vehicles will be significantly reduced; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento Fire, Police and Risk Management Departments, the State Office of Traffic Safety, and Channel 31, are to be commended for their collaborative efforts in making this campaign a reality for the benefit of residents of Sacramento.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend this collaborative effort and do hereby proclaim the week of January 18-22, 1999 as *Please Abide, Move Aside Week*.
