Support SACOG's Green Means Go Pilot-Program: A Program to Enable the Six-County Sacramento Region to Meet a Target of 19 Percent GHG Emissions Reductions By 2035

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento is a member of the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG).
- B. The SACOG region faces an ambitious state-mandated per capita greenhouse gas reduction target of 19 percent by 2035 for the upcoming Metropolitan Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy.
- C. The City of Sacramento is committed to helping the Sacramento region meet its 19 percent greenhouse gas reduction target while, at the same time, providing more affordable housing and transportation choices and advancing economic prosperity.
- D. While the City of Sacramento has made significant strides in facilitating sustainable, transit oriented development, a significant increase in infrastructure investment is necessary if the City is going to meet its share of the Region's growth.
- E. SACOG and its member local governments must work in partnership with the state in order to support housing and transportation projects that will help the region and the state achieve our environmental goals.
- F. The Green Means Go pilot project will be a meaningful and measurable effort to catalyze and advance projects and programs that accelerate infill housing, travel options, and electric vehicle deployment.
- G. The Green Means Go Sacramento regional pilot program will create immediate funding pipelines to launch projects.
- H. The City of Sacramento urges SACOG to continue efforts to secure implementation funding in the state budget.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Sacramento is committed to helping the State of California and the SACOG region reach its 19 percent greenhouse gas reduction goal through implementation of the Green Means Go pilot project.
