RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEED

(For Street Purposes)

WHEREAS, JOHN M. BRUNO and ZULETTA ROSE BRUNO, his wife, have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Grant Deed dated the 5th day of September, 1934, conveying to the City of Sacramento certain real property hereinafter described:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted, the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said deed and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.

Said property above mentioned is described as:

The South Half of Lot 16, Block 45, in "SOUTH SACRAMENTO," (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California).

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the **23rd** day of **August, 1934,** ~~xxx~~, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **McGILLIVRAY CONSTRUCTION CO.**

at the prices specified in **its** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **the easterly one-half of Land Park Drive, from the center line of Vallejo Way to a point 803 feet southerly therefrom; and Vallejo Way, from the easterly line of Land Park Drive to a point 123 feet west of 17th Street,**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2317**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **July 19, 1934,** ~~xxxxxx~~ reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, **and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.**

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Union,** a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.


