

RESOLUTION No. 443

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 8, 1936

RESOLUTION CANCELLING TAXES

WHEREAS, the application of the City of Sacramento for cancellation of the taxes upon the real property hereinafter described, now owned by said City, having been presented; and

IT APPEARING that, under and by virtue of Section 3804-a, Political Code, said taxes should be cancelled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said taxes be cancelled.

The real property upon which said taxes are so cancelled is situated in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and is described as follows:

LOT 17 "VON WALDRON TRACT, being Lot 6 of Louisiana Tract located in S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, T. 8 N., R. 5 E."

(as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California, on May 4, 1910, in Book 10 of Maps, Map No. 26)

The taxes hereinbefore referred to are hereby made to include all of the amounts shown on the delinquent rolls in the City Controller's office.
