

RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY
UNDER DIVISION 4 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, THE
"SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND
MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2550

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection therewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving the Alley between C and D Streets from the easterly line of 32nd Street to the westerly line of 33rd Street, by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus material; installing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with six inch vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; constructing a concrete manhole complete with cast iron curb and cover; constructing a concrete curtain wall where curtain wall is necessary; grading and constructing an hydraulic concrete pavement six inches in thickness.


2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:
Bounded on the North by the northerly lines of Lots 85 to 91 inclusive of Casa Loma Terrace (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), bounded on the East by the easterly lines of Lots 91, 96, 97, 102 of said Casa Loma Terrace; bounded on the South by the southerly lines of Lots 102 to 108 inclusive of said Casa Loma Terrace; on the West by the westerly lines of Lots 85, 84, 112 and 108 of said Casa Loma Terrace.

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is nil.


4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Act of 1911;" with bonds to be issued as authorized under Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4 %) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931."

RESOLUTION APPROVING REPORT AND FIXING TIME AND

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


