SUBJECT: 10th-11th Avenue Sewer Restoration, Phase 1A (C.C. 9722) - Approval of Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Readvertise for Bids

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. No bids were received and authorization to readvertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On July 16, 1985, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the project to insert a slip liner in the existing sewer line running between 10th and 11th Avenues from Land Park Drive to 17th Street and to construct a new sewer line from Land Park Drive to 17th Street along 10th Avenue. The project was advertised for bids, but no bids were received. The plans and specifications have been revised to separate the project into two phases. Phase 1A will install the new sewer line from Land Park Drive to 17th Street along 10th Avenue.

FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$150,000 in the Public Works budget from Sewer Funds for this project. The total amount currently available is \$140,000. The engineer's construction estimate for Phase 1A is \$84,000.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids to be received on September 24, 1985.
