Dear Mr. Castorena:

Per your request, on November 7, 2001, I performed a visual inspection of existing roof framing at the aforementioned residence. The purpose was to determine if the existing roof framing is acceptable to support a light weight tile instead of the existing wood shake.

The existing 1 story residence is approximately 1700 sf with at least three bedrooms. The existing roof framing consisted of pre-manufactured trusses spaced at 24" c.c.. The trusses were constructed of 2x4 df framing members. Over the trusses is 1x4 skip sheathing, 15# felt and wood shake. Please see attachment 1 of 2 for a sketch of the existing roof plan.

Based on the inspection, please be advised that it is structurally acceptable to remove the existing wood shake roofing material that weighs approximately 3 psf and replace it with a light weight tile (6.5 psf or less - 650# per square installed weight) on the aforementioned residence. The new material is approximately 3.5 psf heavier and will not adversely affect the existing roof structure. Please see attachment 2 of 2 for the calculation of the dead load to the top chord of the trusses.

It was noted that the eave members extending out at the front of the garage, at the dutch hip area, had a slight of amount of deflection, within the code allowed limits.

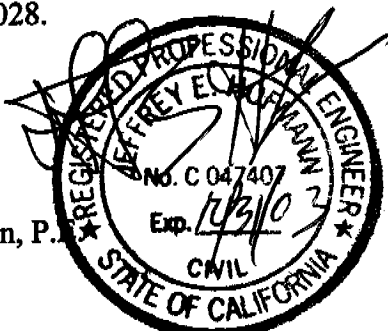
Thus, it is my professional opinion that the removal of the existing wood shake and the placement of the light weight tile will not have an adverse affect on the structural integrity of the existing structure.

This recommendation is based on my initial inspection and if any damaged members become visible during the re-roof process, notify this office immediately such that an additional inspection and fix can be provided.

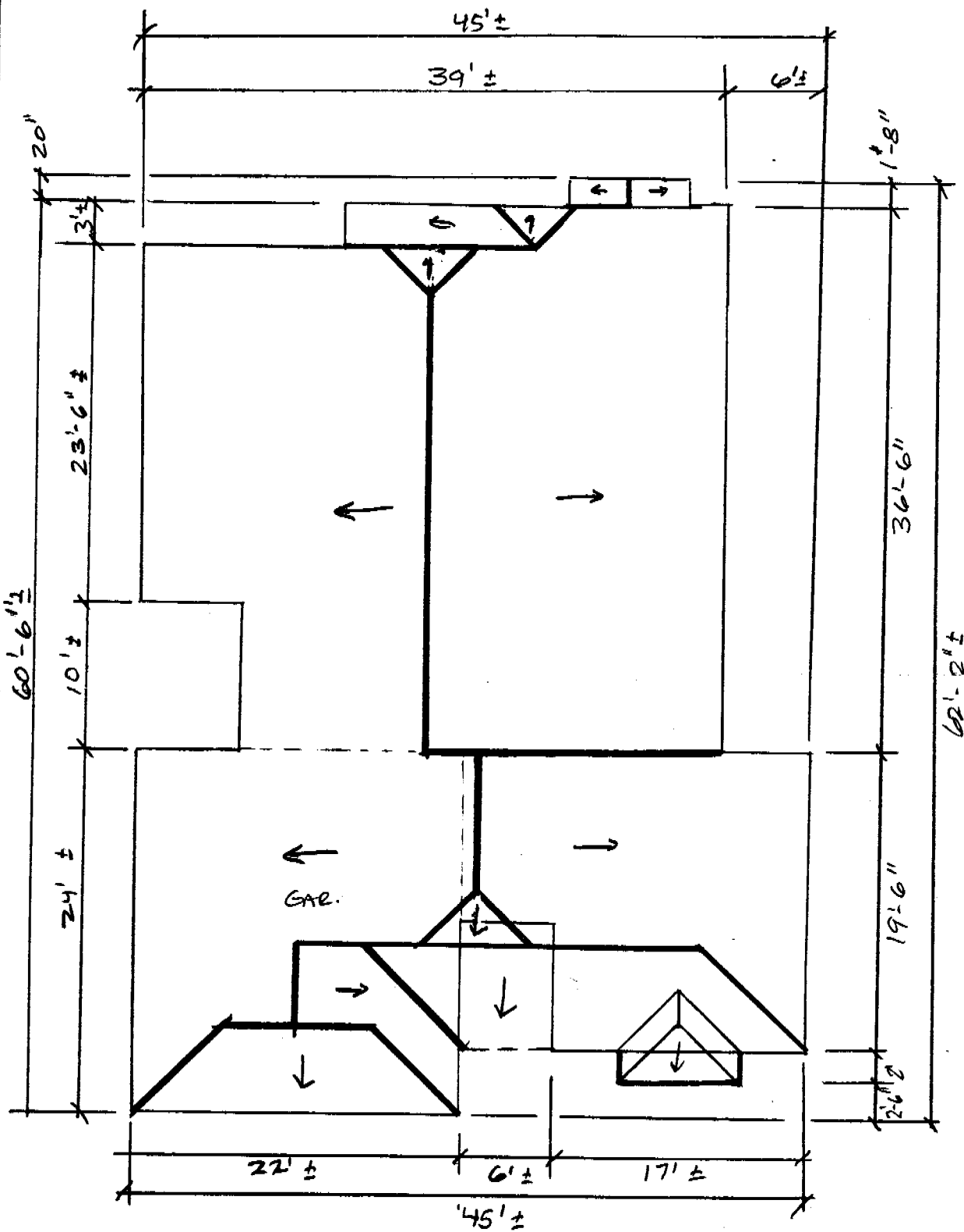
