

ORDINANCE NO. 1451, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE THE CITY'S REQUIREMENT OF ASPHALTIC MATERIAL FOR A 90 DAY PERIOD, WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase the City's requirement of Asphaltic Material for a 90 day period in the open market without first advertising for bids.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate need of such material for the Street Maintenance Division.
