

RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE
BODY UNDER "SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION
AND MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2633

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection herewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving 60TH STREET from the southerly boundary of Fifth Avenue Tract Unit No. 3 (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to the northerly line of 8th Avenue; 62ND STREET from the southerly line of 5th Avenue to the center line of 14th Avenue; 8TH AVENUE from the westerly boundary of Fifth Avenue Tract (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to the easterly boundary of Alta Tract, as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder; 11TH AVENUE from the westerly boundary of Fifth Avenue Tract Unit No. 2 to the easterly boundary of Thelma Tract, as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento; 61ST STREET from the southerly line of 11th Avenue to the northerly boundary of Lawrence Tract, as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder; by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks; installing cast-iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; installing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; installing street monuments; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast-iron curbs and covers; re-constructing existing manholes by placing curbs and covers to proper grade; installing one inch water services were shown on plan; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement;

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:

Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2822(c) reference is hereby made to that certain plat or map on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in Street Work Proceeding No. 2633 which indicates by a boundary line the territory to be included in the Assessment District and which said map or plat is endorsed, "Approved by the City Council of the City of Sacramento this ~~XXXXXX~~ 22nd day of August, 19 47; signed "Mayor".

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is \$1,500.00.

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Act of 1911;" with bonds to be issued as authorized under Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931."
