RESOLUTION AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN LAND USE MAP TO REDESIGNATE 1.155± GROSS ACRES FROM PUBLIC/QUASI-PUBLIC TO LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF FLORIN ROAD AND COUNTRY PLACE, SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA.

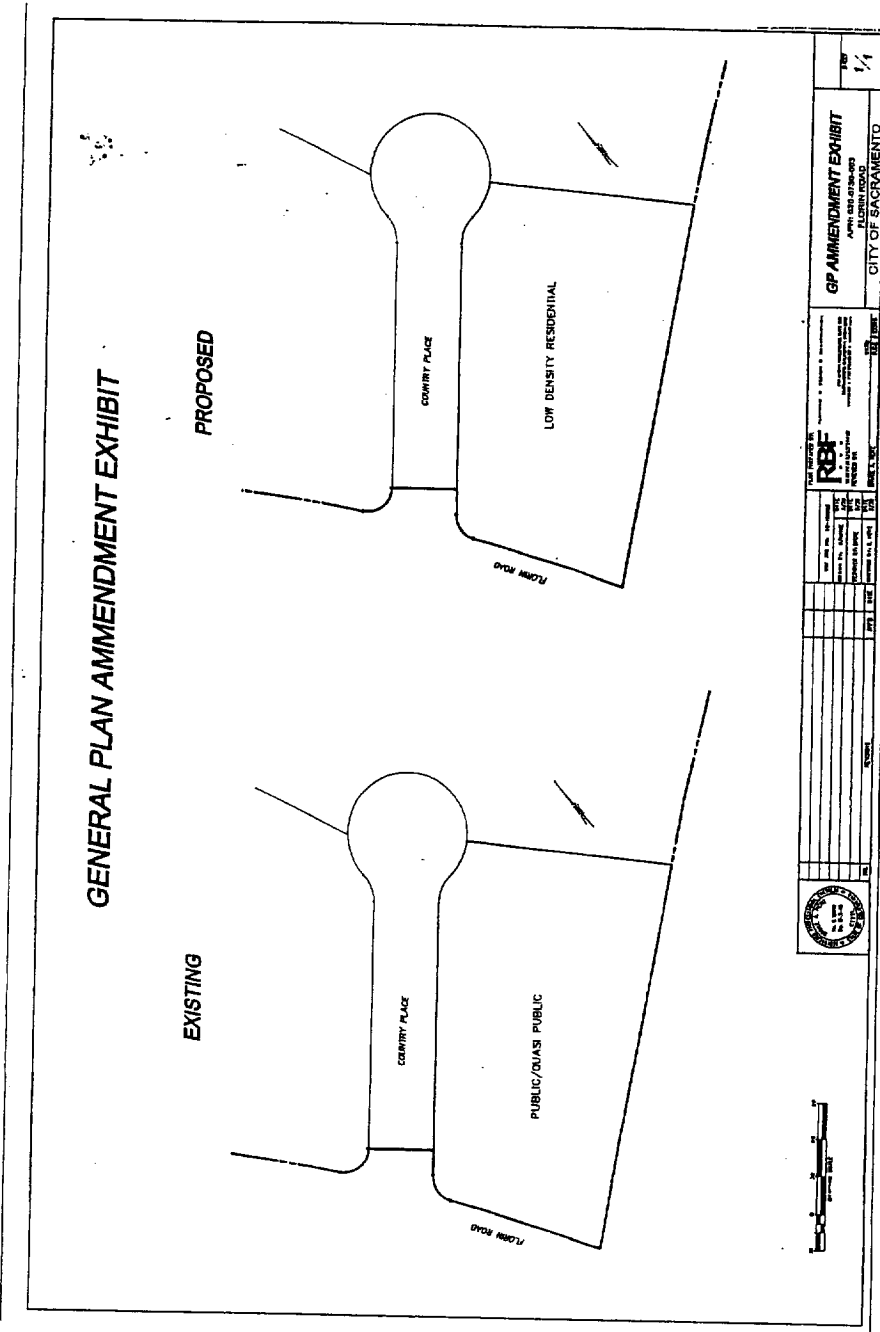
