



RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY  
UNDER "SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND  
MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2581

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection therewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving 53rd Street from the southerly line of V Street to the center line of 2nd Avenue by removing and disposing all refuse and surplus materials; constructing concrete curbs and gutters; installing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; constructing concrete manhole complete with cast iron curbs and covers; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches in thickness; removing and replacing present asphaltic concrete pavement for sewer; constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer.

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:

Bounded on the North by V Street and the northerly line of Lot 3503 and the North line of Lot 3627 both of Map #1 of Elmhurst (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); On the East by the east line of Lot 3501 and the east lines of Lots 3503 and 3513 inclusive of said Map #1 of Elmhurst; On the South by the northerly line of 2nd Avenue; On the West by the westerly line of Lot 3616 to 3627 inclusive and the westerly line of Lot 3629 of said Map #1 of Elmhurst.

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is nil.

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; with bonds to be issued as authorized under the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," approved June 11, 1915, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Section 3 of the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931," approved June 8, 1931, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.
