

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-677

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 12, 2006

APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR NATOMAS BOULEVARD WIDENING PROJECT – PHASE II (PN: TR97)

BACKGROUND

- A. This project will widen the roadway from two lanes southbound to three lanes with a bike lane, construct new curb, gutter, and sidewalk, upgrade storm drain inlets, and relocate the traffic signals on the west side of Natomas Boulevard between New Market Drive and North Park Drive.
- B. This project was advertised and bids were received on August 9, 2006. The bids are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount	ESBD Participation
McGuire and Hester	\$954,471	21.2%
Martin Brothers Construction	\$1,352,577	20%

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$1,314,000. McGuire and Hester is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

- C. Construction is expected to begin in October 2006 and be completed in December 2006.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the Natomas Boulevard Widening Project – Phase II (PN: TR97) are approved, and the contract is awarded to McGuire and Hester for an amount not to exceed \$954,471.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City.

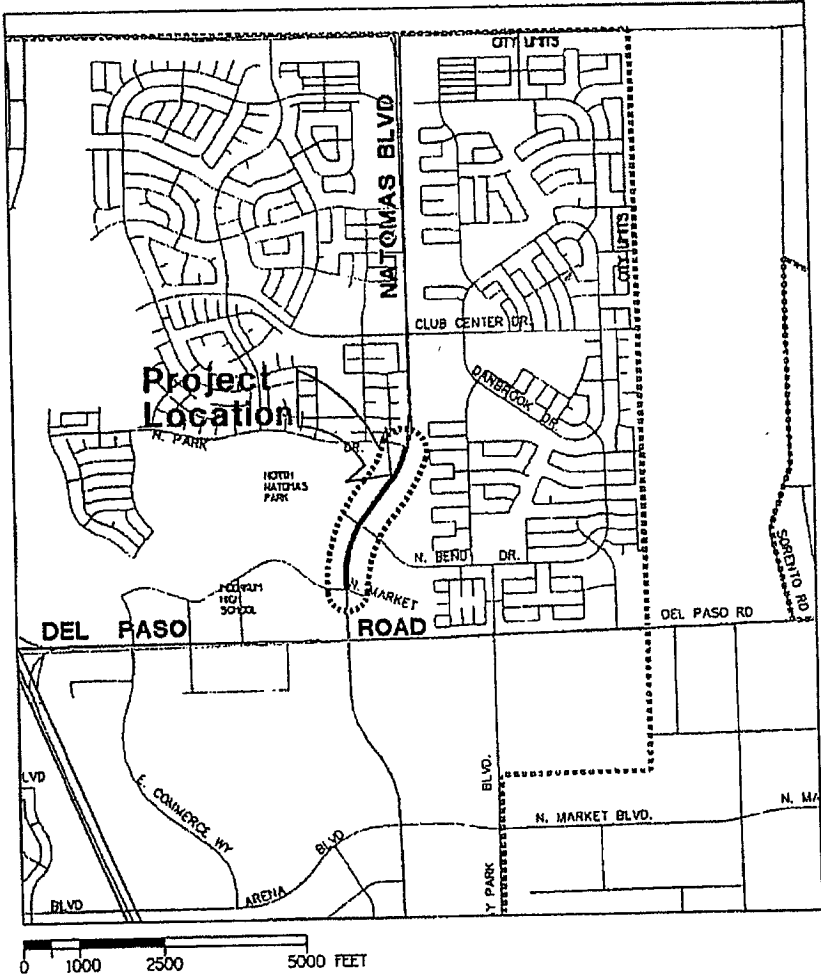
