

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2006-255**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

April 18, 2006

### **REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE POLICE ACADEMY RUNNING TRACK**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Northern California Regional Public Safety Training College was established in 2001 at the McClellan Business Park through a Joint Powers Authority (JPA), which consists of the County of Sacramento, the City of Sacramento, the California Regional Fire and Rescue Training Authority, and the Los Rios Community College District.
- B. The Sacramento Police Academy is located at the Northern California Regional Public Safety Training College in McClellan Park.
- C. In an on-going effort to improve the capabilities of the facility, a running track project has been initiated by the JPA and construction began in fall of 2005. The purpose of the running track is to provide recruits and in-service personnel from the Sacramento Police Department, Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, Sacramento City Fire/Metro Fire Departments and Los Rios Community College District a location to conduct important cardio vascular fitness training.
- D. As a member of the JPA, the Sacramento Police Department will bear a portion of the costs for the academy track project. The Police Department's portion is to fund the installation of the all-weather track surface.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Chief of Police is authorized to reimburse the JPA for the installation of the all-weather running surface, in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.
