

RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT NO. 2496

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of
April 9, 1943

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the costs and expenses of improving westerly side of Franklin Boulevard, from a point 127.67 feet north of the northerly line of 14th Avenue, to the northerly line of the alley first south of 14th Avenue; and 14th Avenue, from the westerly line of Franklin Boulevard, to the westerly boundary of "Capitol Heights" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California),

in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2496;

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this Council upon said Assessment; and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work or in said Assessment; and

WHEREAS, no appeal has been taken to this Council by any person, and the City Council has heard evidence upon said Assessment and the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, and is satisfied with the correctness of the same;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, be, and the same are, hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
