RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A CHANGE IN THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT AND RELATED LEGISLATION - AB 686

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City Council prefers a weighted vote version based on population such as Option 2B, but supports a revised representational composition for the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (SRCSD) Board of Directors; denoted as Option 7, that includes the following provisions:

1. The SRCSD Board would be comprised of: five representatives from Sacramento County, four representatives from the City of Sacramento, one representative each from the cities of Citrus Heights, Elk Grove, Folsom, Rancho Cordova, West Sacramento and, Yolo County.
2. Any future city within Sacramento County that is served by SRCSD would become eligible for independent representation on the SRCSD Board, regardless of population. Each entity would become eligible for one additional representative for each 100,000 increment in population over the threshold of 150,000.
3. If the City of West Sacramento annexes to SRCSD, they would be eligible for one representative to serve on the SRCSD Board. Yolo County would be eligible for one permanent representative (that would be the member of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors whose supervisorial district includes all, or the greater portion of, the population of the City of West Sacramento).
