

ORDINANCE NO. 1024, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THAT CERTAIN ALLEY BETWEEN "R" AND "S" STREETS, FROM THE EASTERLY LINE OF 3RD STREET TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF 4TH STREET, IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: That certain alley in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, lying between "R" and "S" Streets, from the easterly line of 3rd Street to the westerly line of 4th Street, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water pipe, gas pipe and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said alley, or which, from time to time, may be necessary to be placed therein.


Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said alley herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.
