

Resolution of Award No. 2656

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the **27th** day of **February** **1948**, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street-work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **MCGILLIVRAY CONSTRUCTION CO.,**

at the prices specified in **their** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of

**53rd Street from the center line of
9th Avenue East to the center line of
14th Avenue**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2656**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **January 16th** **1948**, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Union** a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.


