RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DEED TO ASSIGNEE

WHEREAS, the BROWN-STOCKER OIL COMPANY, a co-partnership, having purchased from the City of Sacramento LOTS 1, 2, 3 and 4 in BLOCK D "SHOPSIDE ADDITION," in the City of Sacramento, on January 5, 1940; and

WHEREAS, said co-partnership consists of two persons, namely, KENNETH BROWN and CHARLES W. STOCKER; and

WHEREAS, KENNETH BROWN, having sold all of his right, title and interest in said above described property to his co-partner, CHARLES W. STOCKER, now requests that the deed to said property be executed to said CHARLES W. STOCKER and HELEN H. STOCKER, his wife, in lieu of Brown-Stocker Oil Company, a co-partnership;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that that portion of Resolution No. 3 adopted by said City Council on January 5, 1940, wherein the Mayor and City Clerk were authorized to execute a deed to said Brown-Stocker Oil Company, be rescinded, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed to execute a deed to said property to CHARLES W. STOCKER and HELEN H. STOCKER, his wife.
