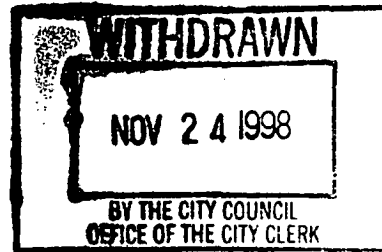

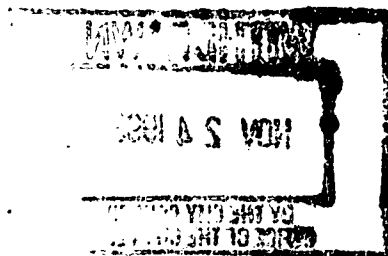
This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution granting citation authority to the classification of Security Officer within the Police Department.

SUMMARY:

The attached resolution grants the classification of Security Officer within the Department of Police authority to issue parking citations to unauthorized vehicles parked in designated "Police Only" parking zones.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Chapter 30, Article III of the Sacramento City Code gives authority to the City Council to grant citation authority to individual employees. After a job classification is designated by the City Manager as needing citation authority, a resolution granting individual employees citation authority is forwarded to the City Council for approval.

The Police Department has limited parking available for authorized police vehicles at the 900 8th Street and 625 "H" Street facilities. The street parking adjacent to the two police facilities is designated as "Police Only" parking. A lease contract for parking on Union Pacific property was recently terminated by Sterling Parking, the agents for Union Pacific. A new month by month leasing agreement was offered at rates double the existing agreement. Existing funding for parking provides for approximately half the pre-existing parking. This, in turn, has required the parking of additional police vehicles on the street in designated "Police Only" zones.

The Police Department utilizes the classification of Security Officer for various functions within the department. The classification is staffed by former law enforcement officers to provide information and facility security at police locations. Authorizing Security Officers to issue parking citations to unauthorized vehicles parking in designated "Police Only" parking zones would assist City Parking Enforcement Officers in enforcing existing parking regulations for these locations.

This report does not constitute a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act according to CEQA guidelines, Section 15061(b)(1) and 15378(b)(3).




